Alex Waddington Y6, Kayleigh Peel Y2, Hailie McNeilly Y3 and Daisy Bowes Y1.

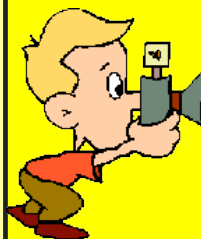
This week Mrs Smith was joined by:

This year celebrates 200 years of the Leeds and Liverpool Canal. The canal society is to replicate a 1st passage and of course it will be coming through our area.



The Kennet, a heritage barge and floating visitor centre, is creating an "inaugural" journey from Leeds to Liverpool over 9 days (although it originally took 5) coming through Barnoldswick on **Tuesday 18th October.**

It will be moving along the Greenberfield area, at the bottom lock 9.30am, then the top lock and leaving the service area by 10.15am continuing on to Lower Park Marina about 11am. It's hoped that people will gather to join in the celebration of what would have been a fine spectacle of "speedy" transport of its time. They plan to recreate the atmosphere of the day, church bells will be ringing for the occasion, flag wavers welcome!
