Pupil Premium Grant

- The Pupil Premium Grant is a government grant which is paid directly to schools to support disadvantaged children directly with their learning and any emotional or behavioural needs should they arise. Your child may be entitled to receive the grant if you are receiving benefits such as Income Support, Child Tax Credit, Working Tax Credit, Universal Credit, along with some other benefits.
- To check if your child is eligible for the PPG you will need your NI number and address
- If you are eligible for the Pupil Premium Grant, you will also be entitled to receive free milk for your child after the age of 5

Lunchtime

In reception all children are entitled to a free school meal. These are from Lancashire's 'Fresher Plus' menu and provide your child with a good balance healthy meal. All meals are made from scratch using fresh ingredients. The menu can also be found on our lunch calendar.
