He will be discussing the new book from Manchester University Press and Pendle Press 'Round Our Way: Sam Hanna's Visual Legacy by historian Heather Norris Nicholson, which documents the incredible work of the 20th century Burnley filmmaker, once dubbed the "Lowry of Film making", as well as other projects.
