What will we be learning this Term?

Our theme in Reception this half term is going to be 'We're Going on a Journey'

This will involve lots of creative and practical activities and plenty of pirate fun. Learning will continue to take place both indoors and outdoors and as always will be based upon very practical and hands-on activities. There will be many opportunities for learning in each of the seven areas of the EYFS, as outlined in more detail below.



Communication and Language- The children will continue to develop their communication skills by speaking in sentences about first hand experiences, answering who, what and why questions, extending vocabulary and asking questions. Communication and Language happens all of the time whilst children are busy learning through play. We have many different activities set up both indoors and outdoors to help with this. This is something you can really develop by talking to your child all of the time through the different stages of the day. E.g. whilst coming to and from school, whilst getting ready for school or bed, whilst having tea...

Personal, Social and Emotional Development- Within this area children will be continuing their learning to follow basic rules and boundaries within the school setting and working together with others. We will also be looking at other rules, looking after others, animals and the environment. We will also be looking at internet safety and jobs in the community. Physical Development- During this half term we will be continuing to develop a range of skills within PE lessons: -Travelling with confidence and skill around, under, over and through balancing and climbing equipment. Showing increasing control over an object in pushing, patting, throwing, catching or kicking it. We shall also be building upon the skills we started to develop in Autumn term too. Children will also be provided with more activities involving cutting with scissors to improve their control and we will also be continuing in holding our pencils correctly to form letters for writing words and sentences.

Mathematics – In Maths the children will continue to represent numbers using their fingers, marks and pictures on paper. Within the environment we will be encouraging children to be curious about numbers and to ask questions about them. We will be concentrating on numbers 0-10 and the concept of each number and what each number means and looks like in different ways. This will include using 10s frame and the part-part whole model. We will be using lots of mathematical language too. More ideas can be found here:-

Literacy- We will be learning literacy skills through reading the books 'Shark in the Park' by Nick Sharrat and 'We're Going on a Treasure Hunt'. We will develop the skill of joining in with stories through Talk for Writing techniques, where children use actions when verbally retelling the stories. Once the children are familiar with them, we then innovate (change) the stories too. Children will be provided with many opportunities to write and draw along with reading too. We will be focusing on listening carefully for the sounds in words in sounding out and blending together to be able to read and write the words. The Phonics sessions that take place on a daily basis really helps with this too. This half term we will be starting on our Phase 3 sounds. Understanding the World – This half term we will be exploring creatures under the sea, floating, and sinking, map skills and different materials. We will also continue with the celebrations that take place during this half term such as Chinese New Year, Valentine's day and Shrove Tuesday and Ash Wednesday. We will be asking questions about the natural world and the changes that Winter brings. We will also be discussing similarities and differences between things we look at.

Expressive Arts and Design – This half term the children will be making a range of different crafting items throughout the term. These will pirate people, boats, sea creatures and drawing and painting of real objects. We will be experimenting with colours and how we can change them and how we can make the different colours. We will be providing various materials so that children can choose what they would like to use in their art work. The children will also be pretending in the role-play and small world areas and they will be working together in making up their own stories.



THINGS TO REMEMBER

- **PE DAYS :** Reception have P.E each week on different afternoons. Please ensure your child has their PE kit in school every day. **(With names in all clothing please as we noticed in the Autumn Term we had many items with no names in still).** Welly Wednesday will start again next week on the 11th January. Remember to send in appropriate clothing for this time of year with the forever changing weather.
- **Home Learning:** Weekly weekend workout activities will be sent home for the children to complete. These may include things linked to letter formation, tricky words, phonic sounds linked to our phonic lessons and number work linked to our maths lessons. Sometimes children may be given different work to other children depending on individual needs.
- **Reading:** Your child will be given a book to read with you every week or when we feel they need a new one. They will be changed twice a week. The children need to sound out the words and blend them together in order for them to read the words independently. This is something we should be able to do around this time of year if your child isnt already blending.
