Well done to the 12 children from Year 3/4 who took part in the West Craven Cluster Athletics Competition Last week along with the 5 other Barnoldswick schools. The children all took part in a range of running, jumping and throwing events throughout the afternoon and finished the competition as WINNERS. The team will now go to the Pendle finals in a few weeks' time. Well done Athletes – we are all very proud of you!



Last week your child received a letter and sponsorship form for an upcoming exciting event happening at Gisburn Road. This event is taking place on Wednesday 12th February from 1:30-3:15pm through a company called Sports for Schools. The aim of this event is to have an ex Olympic Athlete come in to school and talk

about their in sport life to inspire the children. The children will be taking part in a range of fitness testing activities throughout the afternoon before a whole school assembly with Michael Churm. Michael was an ex Paralympic Athlete who suffers with Cerebral Palsy. Despite suffering with this, Michael defied the odds and never gave up believing in his dreams of becoming a Paralympic Short Distance Sprinter. Michael represented Team Great Britain at 3 Paralympic Games and won a silver medal at the World Championships too. The children now have 3 weeks to raise money through their sponsorship forms before returning them to school. 60% of the money we raise as a school will be spent on new PE and Sports After School Clubs equipment to use beyond 2020. The children receive certain prizes if they raise £5, £15 or £30 respectively.
