Burnley FC vs Manchester City – Matchday Experience ‘Guard of Honour’

Dear Parents/Carers,

Your child has been chosen to represent Gisburn Road in a very special event at a Burnley FC match. Your child will be taking part as a pre match mascot on the pitch in a Premier League match vs the current Premier League champions - Manchester City. This match will take place on **Tuesday 3rd December 2019 and the kick off time is 8pm**. Once the game has finished, the children will then be brought back to **Gisburn Road** for around **10:15pm**. Please note all specific information will follow in due course. We understand the time due back is late, so if you feel it is too late for your child to be awake then please let the school know that they won't be attending so we can select another child for the event.

On the day of the event, after school has finished, your child will stay at school and then be taken to Turf Moor by staff that will then stay with your child throughout this entire event. Your child will firstly undergo a one hour coaching session by Burnley FC community coaches in the Elite Training Centre before making their way to their seats in the James Hargreaves Lower Tier. 15 minutes prior to kick off, your child will then make their way on to the football pitch and applaud all the players from both teams on to the pitch - seeing all the stars from both teams up close. After the players have entered the pitch, your child along with staff members will then make their way back to their seats to watch the rest of the game. This event is all organised by Burnley FC in the Community.

The cost for this event is £17. This will include their ticket on to the game, a pre match coaching session in the Elite Training Centre and then finally the 'Guard of Honour' where they'll clap the players on. This **must** be paid before November 22nd. Please note there are only 12 places available for this event. If you as parents would like a ticket on to the game yourselves to see your child take part in the Guard of Honour, then tickets unfortunately can't be organised by Gisburn Road but will be available from the ticket office at Turf Moor.
