Morning Routines

I am asking again for parents to accompany children on the yard prior to **8:45am**. There is no need for children to arrive prior to **8:40am**. The official start time of the school day is **8:55am**. Prior to **8:45am** it is parents' responsibility to supervise their children.

Thank you for your cooperation – we only want to keep all the children safe.

End of Day Routines

To ease the congestion at the gates we are tweaking our end of day routine slightly. Reception and Year 1 will continue their end of day routine at 3:25pm as normal. Year 2 will come out of school down the steps at 3:25pm and parents should collect their child from there. Year 3 and Year 4 will exit their classrooms and proceed to line up on the lower yard from 3:20pm. All Year 3 & 4 parents should wait on the lower yard to collect their child. Year 5 and Year 6 will continue their end of day routine at 3:25pm as normal.

Changes to May Day Bank Holiday

The local authority has advised us that the May Day Bank Holiday has been moved from Monday 4th May 2020 to Friday 9th May 2020. **School will be open on Monday 4th May and closed on Friday 9th May**.
