What will we be learning this Term?

This term our topics will be "Fire! Fire!" and "Growth and Green Fingers". During the first half term we will focus on "Fire! Fire!" and the lead subject areas are History, DT and Music. In History, we will be learning about The Great Fire of London. We will focus on recognising the distinction between past and present, and place events in chronological order using phrases to show the passing of time. In DT we will be creating moving pictures using pop ups and levers showing buildings on fire in London. In music we will be using our voices to create sound. We will focus on singing in unison, tempo and dynamics. We will then use these skills to create our own song about The Great Fire of London. In science we will continue to focus on seasonal changes. We will look at how the weather changes through the seasons and create our own weather reports.
