

PSHE

This half term we will be focusing on Safe relationships and discussing what physical contact is appropriate and feeling safe. We will look at respecting ourselves and others. We will discuss responding respectfully to a wide range of people; recognising prejudice and discrimination.

My Happy Mind – the unit for this half term is CELEBRATE. This Module is all focussed on building children's self-esteem. Children will learn about 5 Character Strengths that make them unique and special and will spot these in themselves and others.

English



This half term we will be studying different Legends from the British Isles. We will start with exploring a variety of stories such as Robin Hood and the Legend of Finn Mccool. we will then move onto a focused study of the story of Gelert. We will work towards writing our own legend based on those we have read. To compliment this learning, our class novel will be Outlaw by Michael Morpurgo and our guided reading text will be Beowulf by Michael Morpurgo.



Mathematics

In maths we will be starting with mental multiplication and division. We will then move on to written division and multiplication with a focus on area within the multiplication. We will look at fractions, equivalent fractions, order, and compare them. We will also study time and timetables.

Science

This half term is a focus on solutions, mixtures and separation. We will test different materials in water – what dissolves and what does not. We will separate materials using sieving, filtering and evaporating.



Computing

This half term we will focus on animation. We will look at original forms of animation before creating our own animations using the technique of taking several pictures on an ipad and creating a sequence.

Religious Education

The focus this half term is on Hindu Dharma.

ART In Art we will be focusing on Drawing Skills. We will start by practicing different drawing skills and techniques using different media and build up to producing an observational drawing of fruit.



Physical Education- This half term we will be **swimming** and also working on team building games with Coach Reece from Burnley Football Club.

History: This half term we will be studying the Anglo Saxons. We will be finding out who the Anglo-Saxons were, where they came from and why. We will use chronology and enquiry skills throughout the unit. Our enquiry focus question is 'What can we learn about the Anglo Saxons from the discoveries at Sutton Hoo?' We will take on the role of archaeologists to look at a variety of sources and artefacts found at Sutton Hoo then communicate our findings using both written and oracy outcomes.

THINGS TO REMEMBER

- **PE DAYS**: Year 5 have PE with BFC on a **Friday** this half term. Please ensure your child has their outdoor kits in school for that day.
- Swimming every Tuesday: Please ensure your child has their full swimming kit.
