## What will we be learning this Term?

#### <u>English</u>

We will study the historical text of Oliver Twist to begin with focusing on the language used by the author. We will draw inferences around the characters' thoughts, feelings, motivations and actions and we will then plan and write our own chapter based on what we have learnt.

#### <u>Maths</u>

We will begin by looking at factors, multiples and rules of divisibility before moving on to some work on time, measurement and then comparing and ordering fractions.

#### <u>Science</u>

We will explore how some materials dissolve in liquids to create solutions and how those materials can be recovered from the solution. We will also develop our knowledge of ways to separate solids, liquids and gases.

#### <u>Topic</u>

We have a tasty treat in store this half-term. We will be grouping food types, tasting a variety of different types of food and learning how to prepare and cook foods from different countries. We will also be learning about aspects of nutrition and the healthy eating plate . We will use a range of maps to find out about places in the world, linking in with where foods are produced and grown.
