Year 2 Class Trip to St Annes Beach



Dear Parents/Carers,

To complement the learning in our Summer term Art and Geography topics, about collage and the world around us, Year 2 will be going on a class trip to St Annes Beach on **Monday 15th June**.

Children will be leaving school and traveling by coach at 8:30am and will be ready for collection at 3:30pm. Please could you ensure all pupils are in school by 8:20am on this day.

The day will include:

- Creating sand art & sketching the landscape using first hand observation
- Studying the physical and human features of the environment around us
- Exploring weather

On the day your child will need:

- a packed lunch in a carrier bag for easier disposal or alternatively can be ordered from school if required (packed lunches are free under Universal Free School Meals for all Year 2 children.)
- to wear own suitable clothing – not school uniform. Pupils must wear trainers, sun cream, a hat and a coat. We know the weather is unpredictable and therefore recommend pupils come to school prepared for a range of weather.

The beach at St Annes is vast and pupils will not be close to the water at any point; therefore, pupils do not need water shoes or swimming clothes.

The cost of the trip will be £20 to be paid through Parent Pay. This includes an ice-cream/ice lolly and a contribution towards the transport. **Please complete the attached form and ensure this is completed and returned to school by Monday 8th June.**

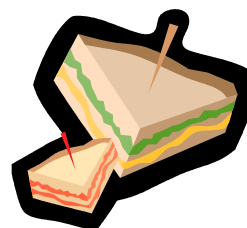

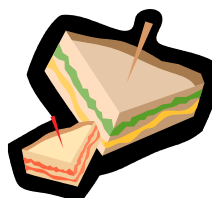
