
GISBURN ROAD COMMUNITY COMMUNITY **Gisburn Road Community Primary School**

This half term we will be focusing on Safe relationships what physical contact is appropriate and feeling safe. We will look at respecting ourselves and others. We will discuss responding respectfully to a wide range of people; recognising prejudice and discrimination.

English –

This half term we will be studying the historical novel 'Oliver Twist'. We will study the period in History, the characters and relationship between them and then write our own chapter to fit in the story. We will also study a range of classic poetry and work on the devices poets use to create their poems.

Mathematics

In maths we will be starting with mental multiplication and division. We will then move on to written division and multiplication with a focus on area within the multiplication. We will look at fractions, equivalent fractions, order, and compare them. We will also study time and timetables.

Science -

This half term is a focus on solutions, mixtures and separation. We will test different materials in water – what dissolves and what does not. We will separate materials using sieving, filtering and evaporating.

Computing -

This half term we will focus on animation. We will look at original forms of animation before creating our own animations using the technique of taking several pictures on an ipad and creating a sequence.

Religious Education -

The focus this half term is on Hindu Dharma

ART/DT-. This half term is a D.T project on world food; focusing on the skills of bridge and claw cut and finer grating. The children will produce a dish following a recipe from different countries.

Physical Education- This half term we will be swimming and also working on a dance unit based on the theme of food, looking at how we can move our body and creating a sequence.

Modern Foreign Langauges : This half term we will be learning the basics of spanish with the help of Miss.....from West Craven- we are very lucky to have her expertise!

Geography: This half term we are looking at World food. How our food gets to our plate, climates it needs to grow, food miles and fair trade.
