## Year 6 Class Trip to Museum of Lancashire- Secret War workshop

Dear Parents/Carers,

To complement the learning in our autumn term history topic about World War II, Year 6 will be going on a class trip to the Museum of Lancashire to take part in a 'Secret War' workshop on **Monday 10<sup>th</sup> November**.

The workshop will include:

- **Spies in the skies** – Meet a representative from RAF Medmenham and learn about aerial reconnaissance during WWII. Try your hand at photographic interpretation using genuine WWII images – can you help Britain learn about the enemy and plan the next strategic operation?
- **D-Day** – It's 1944 and rumours of invasion are in the air! You have the important task of sifting through information gathered behind enemy lines to prepare a document for a top-secret briefing. But time is not on your side and attention to detail, good teamwork and decisive action are essential to the success of your mission.
- **SOE Agents** – Discover the role of the WWII secret agent, and the huge impact they had on the course of the war. Pupils will forge their own ID papers, make gadgets and learn the tricks of the wartime spy.
- **Code breakers** – Meet a code breaker from Bletchley Park and discover the secret war they waged that had a huge impact on WWII.

Children will return for 3:30pm.

On the day we will be having an early lunch before we leave school as there are no lunch facilities at the museum.

If your child would like a school lunch on this day, it will be a sandwich option only.

The cost of the trip will be **£19.25** to be paid through Parent Pay. This includes the cost of the workshop and a contribution towards the transport. Please complete the attached form and ensure this is completed and returned to school by **Friday 24<sup>th</sup> October**.

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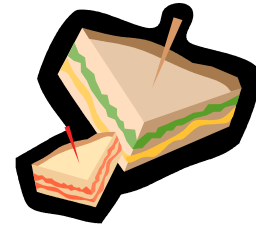

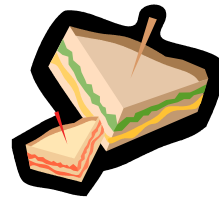
